Recall Summary

Name of Product: Crawley II Executive Chairs

Hazard: The seat plate weld can break, posing a fall hazard to consumers.

Remedy: Replace

Consumers should immediately stop using the recalled chair and contact Office Depot to receive a free replacement seat plate that consumers can install at home.

Recall Details

Units: About 300,000

Description: This recall involves Crawley II executive chairs. The black, high-back, adjustable chairs have a black base with five wheels. The affected chairs have Office Depot SKU number 493822 or OfficeMax item number 23324118 and "US REG. No. PA 25917(CN)" printed on a label located on the underside of the seat cushion.

Incidents/Injuries: Office Depot has received seven reports of the seat plate weld cracking or breaking. No injuries have been reported at <u>OfficeDepot.com</u>.

Sold at: Office Depot and OfficeMax retail stores nationwide and online from October 2012 through September 2015 for about \$140.

Importer/Distributor: Office Depot. Inc., of Boca Raton, Fla.
