SAFETY RECALL ThinkPad Batteries

Lenovo is voluntarily recalling certain lithium-ion batteries manufactured for use with ThinkPad notebook computers that shipped worldwide between October, 2010 and April, 2011. Lenovo will offer customers free-of-charge replacements for all recalled batteries.

Lenovo sold the batteries with new notebook computers or as optional stand-alone or replacement battery packs.

The battery packs can overheat, posing the risk of fire and burn hazard.

Remedy

Consumers who have battery packs affected by this recall should, until the replacement batter arrives, turn off their system, immediately remove the battery, and only power the ThinkPad by plugging in the AC adapter and power cord.

The computer products containing these battery packs range in retail price from \$350 to \$3,000. These battery packs were also sold separately as an option/accessory/replacement pack in limited quantities at a retail price of ranging from \$80-\$150.
